

Director's Update - March 23, 2021

Good afternoon team,

Today Governor Cooper announced <u>Executive Order 204</u>. This order takes effect on March 26th at 5pm. This order lifts significantly eases the current restrictions. Guiding the easing is the fact that cases and hospitalizations are flattening, and 32% of the population has received their first vaccine dose and another 19% are now fully vaccinated. The key points of the new EO impacting our industry are as follows:

- Masks and 6 foot physical distancing remains in effect.
- Max capacity (subject to physical distancing rules) increases to 75% indoors and 100% outdoors for restaurants, breweries, & wineries;
- All curfews have been lifted
- Increases mass gathering limits to 50 indoors and 100 outdoors;
- Bars and taverns may open for indoor consumption at 50% capacity.

We have made progress. Let's keep moving in the right direction. Let's continue to be leaders in our communities. Enforce the #NCBeer Pledge, and encourage your employees to get vaccinated.
